Just As You Are

Romans 12 ; 1 - 3

¹Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. ²Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will. ³For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you.

Focus Points

- **What is important during worship**
It is to see ourselves as we truly are, objectively evaluate ourselves, and repent of our sins.
- **"Think wisely"**
 - This means to carefully examine yourself, judge accurately, and understand who you truly are.
 - It is a call to be humble and not to be arrogant.
- **Why is it difficult to see and discover ourselves objectively?**
 - (1) Because of the fear that comes from shame.
 - (2) Because we hide ourselves due to anxiety.
 - (3) Because we blame others and shift responsibility.
- **The problem of sin is not about actions but about identity.**
The life of faith must begin not with doing, but with being.
