Love is being considerate.

Genesis 13:1-13

So Abram went up from Egypt to the Negev, with his wife and everything he had, and Lot went with him. Abram had become very wealthy in livestock and in silver and gold. From the Negev he went from place to place until he came to Bethel, to the place between Bethel and Ai where his tent had been earlier and where he had first built an altar. There Abram called on the name of the LORD. Now Lot, who was moving about with Abram, also had flocks and herds and tents. But the land could not support them while they stayed together, for their possessions were so great that they were not able to stay together. And quarreling arose between Abram's herdsmen and the herdsmen of Lot. The Canaanites and Perizzites were also living in the land at that time. So Abram said to Lot, "Let's not have any quarreling between you and me, or between your herdsmen and mine, for we are brothers. Is not the whole land before you? Let's part company. If you go to the left, I'll go to the right; if you go to the right, I'll go to the left." Lot looked up and saw that the whole plain of the Jordan was well watered, like the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, toward Zoar. (This was before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah.) So Lot chose for himself the whole plain of the Jordan and set out toward the east. The two men parted company: Abram lived in the land of Canaan, while Lot lived among the cities of the plain and pitched his tents near Sodom. Now the men of Sodom were wicked and were sinning greatly against the LORD.

Focus Points

• Biblical Principle: You reap what you sow.

If you sow to please the flesh, you will reap destruction from the flesh. If you sow to please the Spirit, you will reap life and fruit from the Spirit. If you do good, in due time you will reap a harvest.

The way you treat others will be the way you are treated.

- We must learn to look around and be aware of those around us.
- Consideration means thinking of others first and treating them with special respect and care.

Like the parable of the ox and the lion:

The reason they had to part ways wasn't because they didn't try their best.

but because they lost sight of consideration.
